We declare that our coated paperboard

KORSNÄS WHITE

is suitable for packaging foods. It may stand in direct contact with dry and fatty foodstuffs with both sides. Furthermore it may come into direct contact with moist foodstuffs with its reverse side.

The paperboard is manufactured in accordance with good manufacturing practice, that is to say in such a way that under normal and foreseeable conditions of use it does not transfer its constituents to foods with which it is in contact, in quantities which could endanger human health or bring about a deterioration in organoleptic characteristics of such food. The board is produced only from virgin fibres and chemicals that meet all demands as regulated by:

- Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004 Article 3.
- The German Food Law §§ 30 und 31 in der Lebensmittel-, Bedarfsgegenstände- und Futtermittelgesetzbuch (LFGB)
- The German Recommendation BfR XXXVI revised as of March 1, 2011.
- The American Code of Federal Regulations Title 21 Chapter 1 - FDA Parts 176.170-180 revised as of April 1, 2011.

When packaging aqueous and fatty foods we recommend a functional barrier between the food and the board.

The information contained herein is to our knowledge accurate and reliable. It is the customer's responsibility to assure the appropriate, safe and legal use and handling of our products.

This document is valid until 2012-12-31 or until either the customer requirement or the product has been significantly changed.
