

Certification


Our virgin fibre qualities are based on mechanical pulp without any bleaching steps (therefore without elementary chlorine or chlorine compounds). In the top layer – and at some qualities also in the reversed layer – in addition bought bleached pulp is used. The bleached pulp bought on the market is TCF or at least ECF, depending on the availability.


The Mayr-Melnhof cardboard group mainly produces qualities based on recovered fibres. Virgin fibre used (0 to 10 %, depends on quality) is bought or own produced mechanical pulp (from residues of a saw mill) and bought unbleached and bleached pulp. The bleached pulp bought on the market is TCF or at least ECF, depending on the availability.

The wood is mainly from certified harvesting. Examples for the grade of certifying: Austria nearly 100 % (PEFC certification of areas, about 1 % FSC), Germany > 70 % increasing daily, Czech Republic about 80 % (mainly PEFC).
